The ride will be held at the Drayton Valley Horse Club's Riverside Trails (see map).  
There will be two pleasure rides - one in the morning and one in the afternoon.  
Riders may arrive on May 28 and camp overnight.  
Please keep horses out of the flagged area.

To qualify, a rider must have sponsors who make a specific financial contribution to the  
Drayton Valley Health Services Foundation.  
A minimum of \$15 total donations for riders 14 years and under  
and \$25 for other riders is required.

Coffee and muffins will be served at 8 AM.  
The ride will start at 10 AM sharp.  
Lunch will be served at 12 noon.

The afternoon ride will leave at 1:30 PM and riders will return at 4 PM.  
A supper (free to riders, \$15.00 for non-riders) will follow the ride.  
Prizes will be awarded for the individual top earner (based on the money collected and  
turned in the day of the ride). Also, novelty events, as decided on the day of the ride.

When you arrive the day of the ride, have with you your completed entry form,  
and sponsor sheets. Official tax-deductible receipts will be mailed out to the sponsors  
after the ride.

The safety and wellbeing of all riders and horses is of paramount importance, particularly in an event of this size. We would appreciate your co-operation in the following:

Please refrain from liquor or drugs while on the ride.

Rifles and off road vehicles are not permitted.

No dogs allowed in picnic area or on trails. Dogs must be tied up at all times.

Please refrain from horseplay on the trails (switching other horses, galloping by other riders, etc.).

No leaving the marked trails.

Proper footwear should be worn.

An adult ON AND OFF the ride must accompany children under 14.

The minimum age for any horse entering the ride is (3) years of age and in **good** condition.

While we appreciate some individuals may feel confident in their ability to manage and control a **stallion**; we reserve the right to request that a stallion be withdrawn at any *point* during the ride due to poor manners. We also require that placing a red ribbon in its tail identify stallions and kickers. Also, all stallions must be double tied.

Horses, feed and, transportation are the responsibility of the riders. Water will be available - please bring your own pail and tie your horses to your trailer or the hitching rails. Do not tie horses to the trees.

You are responsible for cleaning up your camp!

We wish to thank all of this year's participants for your support in making this year's Trail Ride Against Cancer a success. Your Cooperation in adhering to these rules will make our jobs a lot easier. We hope that you will join us and enjoy the day.

We once again look forward to seeing you at this Trail Ride against Cancer, which we know will be a great success with your continued support. Cancer attacks our very young, our mothers and fathers, the rich, the poor and even our horses.
